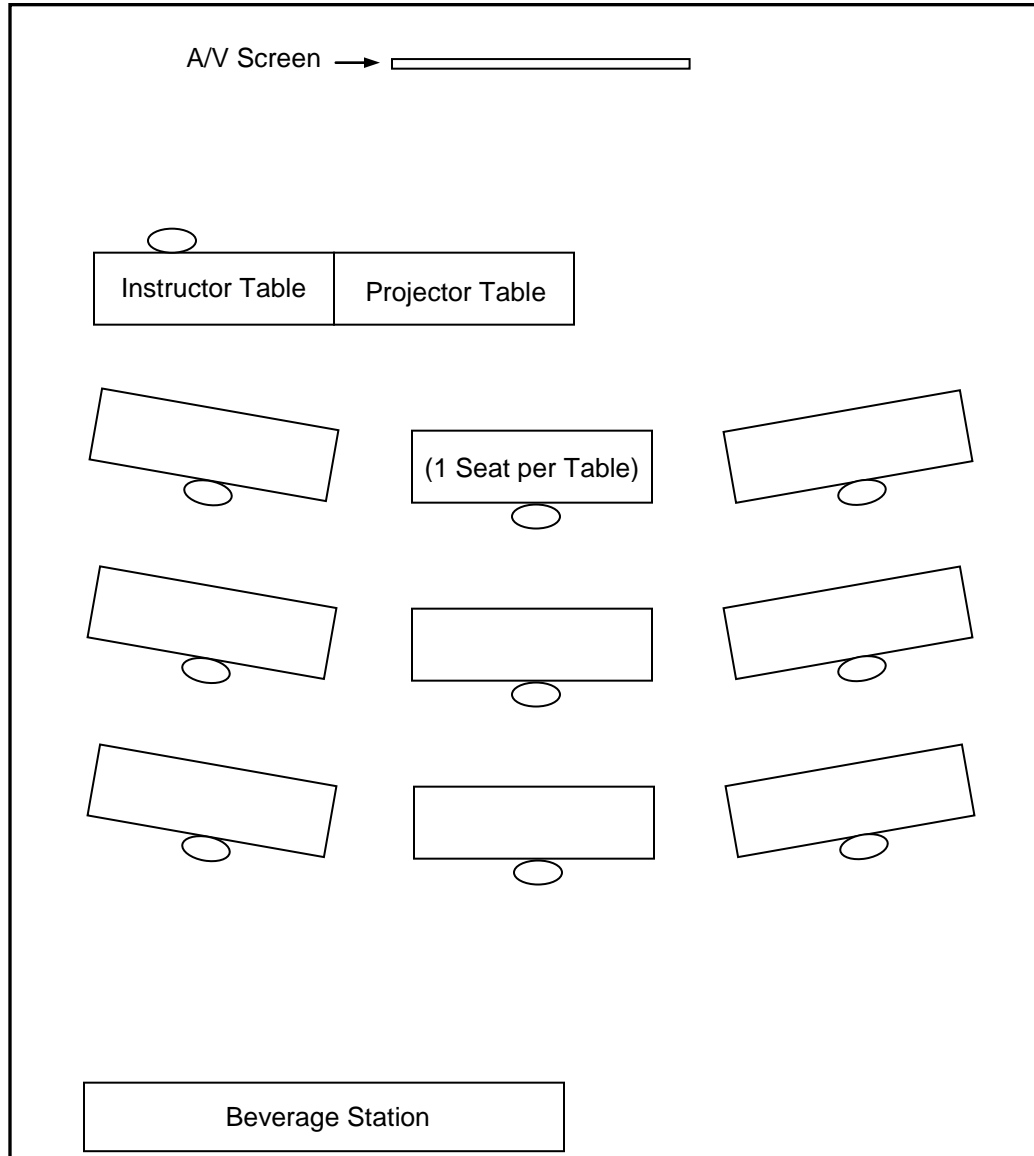

Classroom Health-Safety Precautions

- Maximum of 10 attendees per seminar day, including the instructor.
- Each attendee is seated at their own classroom table and the tables are spaced to separate attendees by at least six to eight feet.
- All attendees (including the instructor) are required to wear a multi-layer [face covering](#) that covers the mouth and nose while in the classroom (inexpensive, disposable three-ply face masks are available via [Amazon](#) and other online/offline retailers).
- Instructor will not shake hands to greet attendees and attendees are encouraged to do the same with each other (an "elbow bump" is a safer alternative).

Warning: Although the above safety precautions are effective in *reducing* the transmission risk of COVID-19 infections, potential registrants concerned that their demographic status and/or underlying health conditions may put them at [higher risk](#) of severe COVID-19 complications should consult with their doctor before registering for a seminar.
